Highlights

- Because the bill will reduce the number of law enforcement escorts for persons hauling farm machinery or equipment, it may yield minimal cost savings for county sheriffs and other law enforcement agencies providing farm vehicle escorts.

Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill exempts a farm equipment permit holder from the requirement to obtain a law enforcement escort when hauling farm machinery or equipment under two conditions: (1) the permit holder hauls the machinery or equipment on a state route other than an interstate, and (2) the distance of the haul is less than ten miles. The exemptions in the bill would potentially result in some minimal cost savings for county sheriffs or other municipal law enforcement agencies that would otherwise have to provide such an escort to haul the equipment. The bill would have no impact on the number of individuals requiring a farm equipment permit nor otherwise have any fiscal impact on the state or political subdivisions.
