"Sec. 5104.321. Beginning July 1, 2027, in calculating 10
payments for publicly funded child care based on a child's 11
attendance under division (C) (1) of section 5104.32 of the 12
Revised Code, all of the following apply: 13

(A) The department of children and youth shall recognize 14
the following as an absent day: any day that the child is 15
authorized and scheduled to be in the care of a provider of 16



publicly funded child care but does not receive the care as 17
authorized, including when the child attended for part of the 18
day but needed to leave early. 19

(B) The department shall not pay a provider for an absent 20
day before the child's actual, initial attendance with the 21
provider. 22

(C) The department shall not recognize a full-time plus 23
authorization. 24

(D) The department shall allow a provider to use an 25
eligible absent day when care cannot be provided due to an 26
emergency or other circumstance beyond the provider's control, 27
which prevented the provider from operating on a day that the 28
child was authorized and scheduled to receive care." 29

R.C. 5104.321 32

Specifies that all of the following apply to the 33
Department of Children and Youth's calculation of payments for 34
publicly funded child care (PFCC) based on a child's attendance: 35

(1) That DCY must recognize as an absent day any day that 36
the child is authorized and scheduled to be in the care of a 37
PFCC provider but does not receive the care as authorized, 38
including when the child attended for part of the day but needed 39

to leave;	40
(2) That DCY is prohibited from paying a PFCC provider for an absent day before the child's actual, initial attendance;	41 42
(3) That DCY is prohibited from recognizing a full-time plus authorization;	43 44
(4) That DCY must allow a PFCC provider to use an eligible absent day when care cannot be provided due to an emergency or other circumstance beyond the provider's control preventing the provider from operating on a day that the child was authorized and scheduled to receive care.	45 46 47 48 49
