The bill has no effect on the revenue or expenditures of the state or political subdivisions. It allows a licensed veterinarian to authorize a registered veterinary technician to establish a veterinarian-client-patient relationship on the veterinarian's behalf for the limited purpose of administering vaccines and antiparasitic medications to dogs and cats, subject to specified supervisory, protocol, and documentation requirements.
