SUMMARY

- Prohibits any judge from requiring a criminal defendant to receive treatment for a substance use disorder or mental health condition at a for-profit or nonprofit entity based solely on the entity's for-profit or nonprofit status.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Prohibited order basis

The bill prohibits any judge, including a judge with a specialized docket for the treatment of substance use disorder or a mental health condition, from requiring a criminal defendant to receive treatment for a substance use disorder or a mental health condition at a for-profit entity or a nonprofit entity, including a faith-based entity, based solely on the entity's for-profit or nonprofit status.¹
