To enact section 3901.93 of the Revised Code to 1  
create within the Department of Insurance an 2  
all-payer claims database. 3

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 3901.93 of the Revised Code be 4  
enacted to read as follows: 5

**Sec. 3901.93.** (A) As used in this section: 6

(1) "Health plan issuer" has the same meaning as in 7  
section 3922.01 of the Revised Code. 8

(2) "Payer" includes a health plan issuer, the medicaid 9  
program, and the medicare program. 10

(B) Not later than one year after the effective date of 11  
this section, the superintendent of insurance shall establish 12  
and administer an all-payer claims database. To the extent 13  
permitted by federal law, each payer shall submit its claims to 14  
the superintendent for inclusion in the database. Such claims 15  
shall be submitted in the format and according to the schedule 16  
prescribed by the superintendent in rule. The superintendent 17  
shall include in the database each claim the superintendent 18  
receives. Claims information included in the database may be 19  
made available to persons or government entities only upon a 20

subscription with the department of insurance. 21

(C) The superintendent shall adopt rules to implement this 22  
section, including rules establishing standards and procedures 23  
for the following: 24

(1) Submitting claims for inclusion in the database, 25  
including the prescribed format and schedule; 26

(2) Maintaining the privacy and security of personal and 27  
health information contained in claims; 28

(3) Making available to persons or government entities 29  
claims information from the database through subscriptions; 30

(4) Imposing penalties when claims are not submitted. 31

The superintendent may adopt any other rules the 32  
superintendent considers necessary to implement this section. 33  
All rules shall be adopted in accordance with Chapter 119. of 34  
the Revised Code. 35

(D) Notwithstanding any provision of section 121.95 of the 36  
Revised Code to the contrary, a regulatory restriction contained 37  
in a rule adopted under division (C) of this section is not 38  
subject to sections 121.95 to 121.953 of the Revised Code. 39
