DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Patrolman Earnest E. Cole Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	All of I-75 in Butler County
Other Information	Patrolman Cole served with the Ohio State Highway Patrol. On October 3, 1964, he was killed in the line of duty when he was struck and killed by a vehicle while directing traffic at the scene of a multiple-car pileup.
