DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	“Patrolman Charles G. Cannon Memorial Highway” ¹
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of U.S. Route 42 between Tarbox Cemetery Road and James Barber Road, in Greene County
Other Information	Patrolman Charles G. Cannon served in the Ohio State Highway Patrol for four years. He was killed on January 1, 1938, while patrolling on his motorcycle when he collided with a dog that suddenly ran into the roadway.
