To amend Section 423.190 of H.B. 96 of the 136th 1
General Assembly to revise the law governing the 2
Child Care Choice Voucher Program. 3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 423.190 of H.B. 96 of the 136th 4
General Assembly be amended to read as follows: 5

Sec. 423.190. CHILD CARE CHOICE VOUCHER PROGRAM 6

(A) Of the foregoing appropriation item, 830604, Child 7
Care, a portion in each fiscal year, along with \$50,000,000 in 8
each fiscal year in appropriation item 830605, TANF Block Grant, 9
shall be used by the Department of Children and Youth to 10
establish and administer the Child Care Choice Voucher Program. 11
Subject to available funds, the program shall provide support, 12
in the form of vouchers, to families to assist them with child 13
care costs. To be eligible to participate in the program, a 14
family must meet all of the following conditions: 15

(1) The caretaker parent is employed or participating in a 16
program of education or training for an amount of time 17
reasonably related to the time that the parent's children are 18

receiving child care. 19

(2) The family does not meet the income conditions for 20
initial eligibility under the Publicly Funded Child Care Program 21
administered by the Department as described in section 5104.30 22
of the Revised Code, but the maximum amount of the family's 23
income does not exceed ~~two~~four hundred percent of the federal 24
poverty line. 25

(3) The family meets any other condition established by 26
the Department. 27

(B) In providing vouchers under this section, both of the 28
following apply: 29

(1) The program shall utilize, not later than November 1, 30
2026, the publicly funded child care payment rates established 31
in section 5104.30 of the Revised Code, except that such payment 32
rates shall not be enhanced payment rates as described in 33
division (E) (2) (c) of that section. 34

(2) If a participating family uses its voucher at a type A 35
family child care home or licensed type B family child care 36
home, the program shall not require the family child care home 37
to be rated through the Step Up to Quality Program administered 38
by the Department as described in section 5104.29 of the Revised 39
Code. 40

Section 2. That existing Section 423.190 of H.B. 96 of the 41
136th General Assembly is hereby repealed. 42
