A BILL

To make appropriations for the Industrial
Commission for the biennium beginning July 1,
2025, and ending June 30, 2027, and to provide
authorization and conditions for the operation
of Commission programs.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. All items in this act are hereby appropriated
out of any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the
designated fund. For all appropriations made in this act, those
in the first column are for fiscal year 2026 and those in the
second column are for fiscal year 2027.

Section 2. RENT - WILLIAM GREEN BUILDING 12

The foregoing appropriation item 845402, Rent - William 13
Green Building, shall be used for rent and operating expenses 14
for the space occupied by the Industrial Commission in the 15
William Green Building. 16

Section 3. Law contained in the main operating 17
appropriations act of the 136th General Assembly that applies 18
generally to the appropriations made in that act also applies 19
generally to the appropriations made in this act. 20

Section 4. The provisions of law contained in this act, 21
and their applications, are severable. If any provision of law 22
contained in this act, or if any application of any provision of 23
law contained in this act, is held invalid, the invalidity does 24
not affect other provisions of law contained in this act and 25
their applications that can be given effect without the invalid 26
provision or application. 27

Section 5. The sections of law contained in this act, and 28
the items of law of which the sections of law contained in this 29
act are composed, are not subject to the referendum under Ohio 30
Constitution, Article II, Section 1d and section 1.471 of the 31

Revised Code and therefore go into immediate effect when this	32
act becomes law.	33
