pamphlet created under division (A) of this section on the web	32

(C) An employer shall provide an employee with a copy of a	34
pamphlet containing at least the information listed in division	35

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injury affecting an employee has occurred.

(D) The bureau of workers' compensation shall maintain an 45 ongoing program to identify employers subject to Chapter 4123. 46 of the Revised Code and to audit employers to ensure an optimum 47 level of premium payment. The bureau shall coordinate such 48 efforts with other governmental agencies which have information 49 as to employers who are subject to Chapter 4123. of the Revised 50 Code. 51

(C) (E) The administrator shall handle complaints through 52 the service offices, the claims section, and the ombudsperson 53 program. The administrator shall provide toll free telephone 54 lines for employers and claimants in order to expedite the 55 handling of complaints. The bureau shall monitor complaint 56 traffic to ensure an adequacy of telephone service to bureau 57 offices and shall compile statistics on complaint subjects. 58 Based upon those compilations, the bureau shall revise 59 procedures and rules to correct major problem areas and submit 60 data and recommendations annually to the appropriate committees 61 of the general assembly." 62 63
