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To enact section 701.11 of the Revised Code to 1  
create the State and Municipal Government 2  
Commission. 3

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 701.11 of the Revised Code be 4  
enacted to read as follows: 5

**Sec. 701.11.** (A) The state and municipal government 6  
commission is created. The commission shall do all of the 7  
following: 8

(1) Analyze and report on proposed state and municipal 9  
policies and rules that would impact municipal home rule 10  
authority; 11

(2) Enhance collaborative opportunities between state and 12  
municipal leaders; 13

(3) Make recommendations to state and municipal leaders on 14  
municipal authority, policy, and funding implications of 15  
proposed state policies; 16

(4) Discuss and consider state and municipal government 17  
revenue sharing, grant programs, and other matters related to 18  
the fiscal health of municipal corporations. 19

<u>(B) The commission shall consist of the following thirteen</u>	20
<u>members:</u>	21
<u>(1) The director of development or the director's</u>	22
<u>designee.</u>	23
<u>(2) The following members appointed by the governor:</u>	24
<u>(a) Two mayors, or their designees, of municipal</u>	25
<u>corporations in the state with populations of sixty thousand or</u>	26
<u>more;</u>	27
<u>(b) Two mayors, or their designees, of municipal</u>	28
<u>corporations in the state with populations of less than sixty</u>	29
<u>thousand.</u>	30
<u>(3) The following members appointed by the president of</u>	31
<u>the senate:</u>	32
<u>(a) One member of the general assembly;</u>	33
<u>(b) One mayor, municipal executive, or charter county</u>	34
<u>executive.</u>	35
<u>(4) The following members appointed by the minority leader</u>	36
<u>of the senate:</u>	37
<u>(a) One member of the general assembly;</u>	38
<u>(b) One mayor, municipal executive, or charter county</u>	39
<u>executive.</u>	40
<u>(5) The following members appointed by the speaker of the</u>	41
<u>house of representatives:</u>	42
<u>(a) One member of the general assembly;</u>	43
<u>(b) One mayor, municipal executive, or charter county</u>	44
<u>executive.</u>	45

<u>(6) The following members appointed by the minority leader</u>	46
<u>of the house of representatives:</u>	47
<u>(a) One member of the general assembly;</u>	48
<u>(b) One mayor, municipal executive, or charter county</u>	49
<u>executive.</u>	50
<u>(C) Each member shall serve a term of two years commencing</u>	51
<u>on the thirtieth day of January of each odd-numbered year.</u>	52
<u>(D) A vacancy on the commission shall be filled for the</u>	53
<u>unexpired term in the same manner as the original appointment.</u>	54
<u>Each member of the commission who is a member of the general</u>	55
<u>assembly shall serve for the duration of the member's term or</u>	56
<u>until that commission member is no longer a member of the senate</u>	57
<u>or house of representatives.</u>	58
<u>(E) Not later than the twenty-ninth day of January of each</u>	59
<u>odd-numbered year, the commission shall prepare and submit a</u>	60
<u>report to the general assembly detailing all of the following:</u>	61
<u>(1) A summary of the commission's recommendation, along</u>	62
<u>with subsequent actions taken or not taken by the general</u>	63
<u>assembly and municipal governments, as appropriate;</u>	64
<u>(2) A summary of legislation passed by the general</u>	65
<u>assembly restricting or limiting home rule authority and any</u>	66
<u>reported impacts on municipal law or policies;</u>	67
<u>(3) Recommendations for the next general assembly to</u>	68
<u>preserve and restore home rule authority and municipal</u>	69
<u>authority.</u>	70
<u>(F) The director of development or the director's designee</u>	71
<u>shall serve as chairperson of the commission. A majority of</u>	72
<u>members constitute a quorum.</u>	73

(G) The commission shall meet at the call of the 74  
chairperson at least biannually. The chairperson shall provide 75  
members with at least ten days' written notice of a meeting. The 76  
commission is subject to section 121.22 of the Revised Code. The 77  
Ohio government telecommunications service shall broadcast all 78  
meetings of the commission. The commission may allow experts or 79  
other parties to testify before the commission. 80

(H) Members shall serve without compensation except to the 81  
extent that serving on the commission is considered part of the 82  
member's regular duties of employment. The commission shall 83  
reimburse each member for actual and necessary expenses incurred 84  
in the performance of the member's official duties. Membership 85  
on the commission shall not constitute holding another public 86  
office. 87

(I) The commission shall not issue a recommendation or 88  
report without approval from at least all of the following: 89

(1) A simple majority of total members; 90

(2) Two members from each political party; 91

(3) Two members who are members of the general assembly; 92

(4) Two members who are a mayor, a mayor's designee, a 93  
municipal executive, or a charter county executive. 94

(J) The commission may hire and supervise an executive 95  
director, who shall be located in the department of development, 96  
to administer the commission's duties. 97

**Section 2.** The Governor, President and Minority Leader of 98  
the Senate, and Speaker and Minority Leader of the House of 99  
Representatives, in accordance with division (B) of section 100  
701.11 of the Revised Code as enacted by this act, shall make 101

initial appointments to the State and Municipal Government	102
Commission not later than June 30, 2026. The initial members	103
shall serve until their successors are appointed as specified in	104
section 701.11 of the Revised Code as enacted by this act.	105
