Requires a professional sports franchise owner desiring to

move to a new facility, in lieu of an agreement permitting the

owner to do so, to give six months' written notice to its host

political subdivision, rather than just notice.

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Permits an owner of a professional sports team using a 50 tax-supported facility to move to a new facility if the new 51 facility is located within the state. 52

Maintains current law requirements for owners seeking to 53 move a team to a facility located outside of the state. 54

Deems any lease or similar agreement entered into with the 55 political subdivision (including agreements entered into before 56 the amendment's effective date), upon the expiration of the term 57 of the lease or agreement, an agreement permitting the team to 58 play most of its home games at a different facility, if the 59 different facility is located within the state, and the lease or 60 agreement expressly obligates the professional sports team to 61 play all or most of the professional sports team's regular 62 season home games at a tax-supported facility for the term of 63 the lease or agreement. 64

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
