"Section 291.30. OHIO STUDENT EYE EXAM PROGRAM 13

(A) The Department of Health shall establish and 14
 administer the Ohio Student Eye Exam Program, to be known as the 15
 OhioSEE Program. Under the program, vision care services, 16
 including vision screenings, eye examinations, and glasses, may 17
 be provided to Ohio students, kindergarten through third grade, 18
 who fail vision screenings and lack access to follow-up care. 19

(B) In administering the program, the Department shall 20
 focus on improving the percentage of vision care referrals 21
 completed, increasing student access to eye examinations, and 22
 providing necessary eyewear to eligible students." 23

Sections 291.10, 291.20, and 291.30 26

Restores Executive provisions requiring ODH to establish 27
 and administer the Ohio Student Eye Exam Program (OhioSEE 28
 Program), a program under which vision care services may be 29
 provided to students in grades kindergarten through 3 who fail 30
 vision screenings and lack access to follow-up care. 31

Also restores the requirement that, in administering the 32
 program, ODH focus on improving the percentage of vision care 33
 referrals completed, increasing student access to eye exams, and 34
 providing necessary eyewear to eligible students. 35

Re-establishes GRF ALI 440496, Children's Vision Services,	36
with an appropriation of \$5,000,000 in each fiscal year for the	37
provision of vision care services under the OhioSEE Program.	38
