After line 156841, insert:

"**Section 751.20.** (A) The Department of Medicaid shall conduct a comprehensive study on the feasibility, legality, and potential cost savings of establishing a Medicaid waiver component that establishes work requirements for Medicaid recipients and includes additional supplemental workforce development requirements.

(B) As part of the study required under this section, the Department shall evaluate the impact of requiring Medicaid recipients who maintain eligibility by satisfying work requirements for twelve consecutive months to enroll in a workforce development program that satisfies either of the following:

(1) The program is a state-sponsored workforce development program that can be completed within twelve months.

(2) The program is one that is offered through a private or public training facility, community college, or university that can be completed within twelve months.

(C) The study required under this section shall assess all



of the following:	20
(1) The legal feasibility of implementing the requirements described in division (B) of this section;	21 22
(2) The workforce development training capacity within this state;	23 24
(3) The potential cost savings associated with implementing the requirements described in division (B) of this section;	25 26 27
(4) The projected impact on Medicaid enrollment in this state if the requirements described in division (B) of this section were to be implemented.	28 29 30
(D) Not later than September 1, 2026, the Medicaid Director shall prepare a report detailing the Department's findings of the study conducted under this section, including any policy recommendations. The report shall be submitted to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President of the Senate, and the chairperson of the finance committee of both the House of Representatives and Senate."	31 32 33 34 35 36 37
