"**Sec. 3318.032.** (A) Except as otherwise provided in divisions ~~(C)~~(B), (D), and ~~(D)~~(E) of this section, the portion of the basic project cost supplied by the school district shall be the ~~greater of:~~

~~(1) The required percentage of the basic project costs,~~

~~(2) (a) (B) For all districts except a district that opts to divide its entire classroom facilities needs into segments to be completed separately as authorized by section 3318.034 of the Revised Code, an amount necessary to raise the school district's net bonded indebtedness~~ the portion of the basic project cost supplied by the school district for the first segment shall be calculated using the required percentage of the basic project costs, as of the date the controlling board approved the project, ~~to within five thousand dollars of the required level of indebtedness.~~ Any future segment's portion of the basic project cost shall use the same respective share as the first segment.

~~(b) For a district that opts to divide its entire classroom facilities needs into segments to be completed separately as authorized by section 3318.034 of the Revised Code, an amount necessary to raise the school district's net bonded indebtedness, as of the date the controlling board approved the project, to within five thousand dollars of the following:—~~

~~The required level of indebtedness X (the basic project cost of the segment as approved by the controlling board / the estimated basic project cost of the district's entire classroom facilities needs as determined jointly by the staff of the Ohio facilities construction commission and the district)—~~

~~(B)~~ (C) The amount of the district's share determined under this section shall be calculated only as of the date the controlling board approved the project, and that amount applies throughout the sixteen-month period permitted under section 3318.05 of the Revised Code for the district's electors to approve the propositions described in that section. If the amount reserved and encumbered for a project is released because the electors do not approve those propositions within that period, and the school district later receives the controlling board's approval for the project, subject to a new project scope and estimated costs under section 3318.054 of the Revised Code, the district's portion shall be recalculated in accordance with this section as of the date of the controlling board's subsequent approval.

~~(C)~~ (D) At no time shall a school district's portion of the

basic project cost be greater than ninety-five per cent of the 47
total basic project cost. 48

~~(D)~~ (E) If the controlling board approves a project under 49
sections 3318.01 to 3318.20 of the Revised Code for a school 50
district that previously received assistance under those 51
sections or section 3318.37 of the Revised Code within the 52
twenty-year period prior to the date on which the controlling 53
board approves the new project, the district's portion of the 54
basic project cost for the new project shall be the lesser of 55
the following: 56

(1) The portion calculated under division (A) of this 57

(2) The greater of the following: 59

(a) The required percentage of the basic project costs for 60

(b) The percentage of the basic project cost paid by the 62

R.C. 3318.032 67

Restores an Executive and House version provision that: 68

- Modifies the calculation of the portion of the basic project cost a school district must provide for its Classroom Facilities Assistance Program (CFAP) project from the greater of either (1) the required percentage based on its equity ranking or (2) an amount necessary to raise the school district's net bonded indebtedness to a prescribed level, to its portion being determined by only the required percentage based on its equity ranking.

- Requires, for a district that opts to segment its classroom facilities project, its local share for the first segment to be calculated using the required percentage of the basic project, instead of the greater of either (1) the required percentage based on its equity ranking or (2) an amount necessary to raise the school district's net bonded indebtedness to a prescribed level. Requires that any future segment's portion of the basic project cost use the same share as used in the first segment.
