Restores House version provisions that prohibits each	18
state university from charging a guaranteed amount of tuition	19
and fees to the cohort entering in the 2025-2026 or 2026-2027	20
academic year that is more than 3% above what was charged to the	21
prior academic year's cohort.	22
Removes Senate version provisions that:	23
- Increases from 3% to 4% the amount that a state	24
university may increase its guaranteed amount of tuition and	25
fees over what was charged in the prior academic year for a	26
cohort entering in the 2025-2026 or 2026-2027 academic year.	27
- Authorizes, for cohorts entering a state university	28
beginning in the 2027-2028 academic year and cohorts thereafter,	29
a state university to increase the percentage of the tuition and	30
fees it may charge a cohort under the tuition guarantee program	31
by either (1) the percentage amount the General Assembly	32
restrains increases for the applicable fiscal year or, if the	33
General Assembly does not set a limit on the increase, (2) the	34
average rate of inflation, as measured by the Consumer Price	35
Index, for the previous 36-month period, instead of the sum of	36
both or no limit if the General Assembly does not enact a limit	37
on the increase as under current law.	38
