**Disposal or demolition of school district property** 20

**R.C. 3313.41 (removed) and 3313.413** 21

Removes the House and Senate version provisions that: 22

- Require a school district, prior to demolishing a 23

building worth more than \$10,000, to offer that building to 24

other qualifying schools under the law regarding the right to 25

first refusal to purchase district real property. 26

- Exempt from that requirement a building that is located 27

on, or adjacent to, a tract or parcel of land where other school 28

district buildings that are used for educational instruction are 29

located. 30

- Permit a district to offer a building it plans to 31

demolish for sale at a public auction if it is not initially 32

purchased under the right of first refusal law. 33

- Add chartered nonpublic schools and educational service 34

centers to the list of qualifying schools to which districts 35

must offer property under the right of first refusal law. 36

- Require a school district board to accept the highest 37

bid at a public auction of a real or personal property.
