"Of the foregoing appropriation item 195455, Appalachia Assistance, 8  
\$1,500,000 in each fiscal year shall be allocated to the Appalachian Ohio 9  
Manufacturers Coalition, to create a pilot program in Meigs, Athens, 10  
Morgan, Noble, Monroe, and Washington counties to reduce barriers of 11  
workforce reentry for individuals who have graduated from behavioral 12  
health recovery programs. The program shall be jointly developed and 13  
administered with the Appalachian Children Coalition, in consultation with 14  
the Director of the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction 15

Increases GRF ALI 195455, Appalachia Assistance, by 36  
\$525,000 in each fiscal year. 37

Removes an earmark under GRF ALI 195455 of \$2,750,000 in 38  
each fiscal year for the Foundation for Appalachian Ohio. 39

Increases an earmark under GRF ALI 195455, Appalachia Assistance, by \$150,000 in each fiscal year for Ohio University's Voinovich School of Leadership and Public Service to work on behalf of the Mayor's Partnership for Progress.

Makes the following earmarks under GRF ALI 195455, Appalachia Assistance:

-- \$1,500,000 in each fiscal year for the Appalachian Ohio Manufacturers Coalition, to create a pilot program in Meigs, Athens, Morgan, Noble, Monroe, and Washington counties to reduce barriers of workforce reentry for individuals who have graduated from behavioral health recovery programs. The program shall be jointly developed and administered with the Appalachian Children Coalition, in consultation with the Director of the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services.

-- \$750,000 in each fiscal year for the Outdoor Recreation Council of Appalachia.

-- \$375,000 in each fiscal year for FosterHub in Hocking County.

-- \$250,000 in each fiscal year for Integrated Services for Behavioral Health to support a behavioral health emergency pilot program.

-- \$100,000 in each fiscal year for the Tuscarawas County Commissioners for the Tuscarawas County Growth Initiative.

-- \$150,000 in each fiscal year for the City of Athens to support a southeast Ohio regional agricultural initiative.
