**"Section 381.215. MILITARY AND VETERANS OFFICES**

(A) The foregoing appropriation item 235450, Military and Veterans Offices, shall be used by the Chancellor of Higher Education to support higher education institutions that are members of the Ohio Veterans Education Council. The Chancellor may consult with the Director of Veterans Services as needed.

(B) Of the foregoing appropriation item 235450, Military



and Veterans Offices, up to \$213,750 in each fiscal year shall 15  
be used by the Chancellor to provide awards of \$2,500 per 16  
student to up to six students serving as a Military Community 17  
Advocate at an Ohio Veterans Education Council-member public 18  
university and up to three students serving as a Military 19  
Community Advocate at an Ohio Veterans Education Council-member 20  
public community college or private nonprofit university or 21  
college. 22

(C) Of the foregoing appropriation item 235450, Military 23  
and Veterans Offices, \$255,000 in each fiscal year shall be used 24  
for grants for military and veterans offices at institutions of 25  
higher education to support growth in private philanthropy, in 26  
collaboration with the National Veterans Leadership Foundation. 27

(D) Of the foregoing appropriation item 235450, Military 28  
and Veterans Offices, \$91,800 in each fiscal year shall be used 29  
to sponsor staff from military and veterans offices at 30  
institutions of higher education to attend the National Veterans 31  
Leadership Foundation's Advancement Institute. 32

(E) The remainder of the foregoing appropriation item 33  
235450, Military and Veterans Offices, shall be used to do all 34  
of the following: 35

(1) Support the administrative costs of the National 36  
Veterans Leadership Foundation; 37

(2) Create a web site to connect veterans to programs and 38  
offerings at all Ohio Veterans Education Council-member colleges 39  
and universities; 40

(3) Administer membership and Ohio Purple Star status; 41

(4) Facilitate information sharing; 42

(5) Support any other expenses as determined appropriate 43  
 by the Chancellor, in consultation with the National Veterans 44  
 Leadership Foundation." 45

### SYNOPSIS

#### **Department of Higher Education**

#### **Sections 381.10 and 381.215**

Restores to the House-passed version all of the following:

- GRF ALI 235450, Military and Veterans Offices, with 50  
 appropriations of \$1,144,000 in each fiscal year, to be used by 51  
 the Chancellor of Higher Education to support higher education 52  
 institutions that are members of the Ohio Veterans Education 53  
 Council (OVEC). 54

- The following earmarks from GRF ALI 235450 in each 55  
 fiscal year: 56

(1) up to \$213,750 to award scholarships of \$2,500 to 57  
 students who serve as military community advocates, including up 58  
 to six students at each OVEC public university and up to three 59  
 students each at other OVEC institutions; 60

(2) \$255,000 for grants to military and veterans offices 61  
 at institutions of higher education to support growth in private 62  
 philanthropy, in collaboration with the National Veterans 63  
 Leadership Foundation (NVLF); 64

(3) \$91,800 to sponsor military and veterans offices' 65

staff to attend the Advancement Institute conducted by NVLF; and 66

(4) the remainder (at least \$583,450) to support NVLF in 67

the creation of its website and other administrative costs. 68
