<b>Adult-use marijuana excise tax distribution</b>	29
<b>R.C. 3780.22; Sections 387.10, 387.20, and 509.10</b>	30
Changes the distribution of the 10% adult-use marijuana excise tax such that 36% of all receipts are permanently distributed to municipalities and townships that host adult-use dispensaries, while the remaining 64% is credited to the GRF. The House and the Senate had allocated all the revenue to the GRF, except that each provided a five-year allocation of 20% to certain host localities.	31 32 33 34 35 36 37
