R.C. 3901.96	36
Specifies that healthcare benefit coverage provided by a	37

nonprofit agricultural membership organization, as opposed to 38 the organization itself, is exempt from state insurance laws. 39 Prohibits a nonprofit agricultural membership organization 40 from representing that the healthcare benefit coverage it 41 provides to its members is insurance in any official written 42 materials or verbal communications to current or prospective 43 members and their families ("material marketing"). 44 Requires, as a condition of the exemption, that the 45 application for healthcare benefit coverage and any contract 46 provided to a member be in writing and prominently state that 47 the coverage is not insurance and is not subject to state 48 insurance laws. 49 Adds references to the Physician-Health Plan Partnership 50 Act and the law governing multiple employer welfare agreements 51 to the list of state insurance laws from which the healthcare 52 benefit coverage is exempted. 53
