BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):

WHEREAS, The General Assembly has consistently demonstrated	3		
its belief that military members and veterans who serve or have	4		
served in hostile environments should be recognized; and	5		
WHEREAS, The United States military maintained a presence	6		
in Honduras throughout the 1980s and 1990s, providing training	7		
and conducting military exercises with the host nation; and	8		
WHEREAS, The presence of U.S. troops served as a deterrent	9		
to aggression in the region and as a means of support for	10		
democratic values through civil action in Honduran communities;			
and	12		
WHEREAS, U.S. troops were equipped with live ammunition and	13		
assisted the Honduran military in training and combat support;	14		
and	15		
WHEREAS, U.S. troops in Honduras experienced hostile fire	16		
and imminent danger; and	17		
WHEREAS, At least one U.S. service member received a Purple	18		
Heart because of terrorist activity in Honduras; and	19

WHEREAS, U.S. troops lost their lives while in Honduras due	20
to terrorist activity and hazardous circumstances; now therefore	21

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 136th General	23
Assembly of the State of Ohio, urge Congress to issue an Armed	24
Forces Expeditionary Medal, or similar recognition for having	25
served in an area of hostility, to all U.S. troops who served in	26
Honduras from 1981 to 1992; and be it further	27
RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House of Representatives	28
transmit duly authenticated copies of this resolution to the	29
majority and minority leaders of the U.S. Senate, the majority	30
and minority leaders of the U.S. House of Representatives, each	31
member of the Ohio congressional delegation, and to the news	32
media of Ohio.	33
