BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):

WHEREAS, The 250th anniversary of the signing of the U.S.	5
Declaration of Independence is on July 4, 2026; and	6

WHEREAS, President Donald Trump established Task Force 250	7
to provide a grand celebration worthy of the momentous occasion	8
of the 250th anniversary of American Independence and to honor	9
the history of our great Nation; and	10

WHEREAS, Students and schools should join in the meaningful	11
celebrations taking place nationally in recognition of the 250th	12
anniversary of the Declaration of Independence; and	13
