WHEREAS, The United States Army celebrated its 250th	3
anniversary on June 14, 2025, commemorating the Army's	4
distinguished service to our nation; and	5
WHEREAS, The Army is a year older than the United States	6
itself; and	7
WHEREAS, Since its establishment, Army soldiers, families	8
and civilians have supported our nation, bearing true faith and	9
allegiance to the country, the Constitution, their units and	10
fellow team members as they defend the nation and provide	11
assistance in times of need, including disaster relief and	12

WHEREAS, General George Washington requested that chaplains	14
be added to the Army to meet the religious and spiritual needs	15

WHEREAS, At the request of Washington, the Continental	17
Congress authorized one chaplain for each regular regiment of	18
the Continental Army; and	19
WHEREAS, The Army Chaplain Corps, formed just weeks after	20
the United States Army itself, was formally established on July	21
29, 1775; and	22
WHEREAS, For 250 years, the United States Army has offered	23
endless possibilities and opportunities for service to our	24
nation. With over 200 career choices for soldiers and more than	25
500 career paths for civilians, Army possibilities are endless;	26

WHEREAS, The Army helps create a sense of purpose through	28
personal growth and professional development - empowering	29
soldiers and civilian employees to be part of something greater	30
than themselves and to be all they can be; now therefore be it	31
