BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):

WHEREAS, In September 2025, the outstanding public debt of	5	
the United States totaled more than \$37 trillion, with public	6	
debt equaling 123% of gross domestic product, and the debt owed		
per citizen rising to \$108,000; and	8	
WHEREAS, More than \$8 trillion of the federal debt is owned	9	
by individuals not located in the United States, including more		
than \$800 billion owned by individuals in China; and		
WHEREAS, In fiscal year 2024, the United States had a	12	
deficit of over \$1 trillion after the United States Congress		
failed to pass a balanced budget, and federal tax receipts		
totaled \$5 trillion, short of the federal outlays totaling \$6.75		
trillion; and		
WHEREAS, The Social Security and Medicare Boards of	17	
Trustees project that the Old-Age and Survivors Insurance Trust

Fund and the Federal Hospital Insurance Trust Fund will be	19
depleted in 2033 and 2036; and	20
WHEREAS, Improvements in the business climate in populous	21
countries and aging populations around the world likely will	22
contribute to higher global interest rates, which would squeeze	23
all United States policy priorities, including defense and	24
foreign policy; and	25
WHEREAS, On September 22, 2011, former Chairman of the	26
Joint Chiefs of Staff, Michael Mullen warned, "the single	27
biggest threat to our national security is debt"; and	28
WHEREAS, On March 6, 2018, then Director of National	29
Intelligence Dan Coats warned, "Our continued plunge into debt	30
is unsustainable and represents a dire future threat to our	31
economy and to our national security"; and	32
WHEREAS, The payment on the interest of national debt now	33
exceeds total United States Defense spending causing future	34
uncertainty over the ability to defend our national interests;	35
now therefore be it	36
RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 136th General	37
Assembly of the State of Ohio, recognize that the national debt	38
is a threat to the national security of the United States and	39
urge the United States Congress to commit to establishing an	40
effective regular order for budgeting; and be it further	41
RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House of Representatives	42
transmit duly authenticated copies of this resolution to each	43
member of the Ohio Congressional delegation and to the news	44
