A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To recognize the 250th anniversary of the United States 1
Postal Service, to express appreciation for its 2
enduring service, and to support continued efforts to 3
ensure the long-term strength, efficiency, and 4
accessibility of the United States Postal Service. 5

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):

WHEREAS, For 250 years, the United States Postal Service 6
(USPS) has faithfully connected communities across our nation by 7
providing universal mail service to every address in America, 8
regardless of geography or income; and 9

WHEREAS, The USPS delivers vital goods and services— 10
including prescriptions to seniors and veterans, shipments for 11
small businesses that drive local economies, mail and supplies 12
to farmers and rural families, and dependable service to every 13
corner of the nation, including areas that private carriers 14
often cannot efficiently reach; and 15

WHEREAS, The USPS has long been one of the most trusted and 16
respected public institutions in the United States, providing 17

reliable, affordable, and secure service to households, 18
businesses, and government agencies alike; and 19

WHEREAS, The men and women of the USPS embody a proud 20
tradition of public service—working in every kind of weather and 21
circumstance to ensure that mail and packages are delivered 22
promptly and safely; and 23

WHEREAS, The USPS plays an essential role in supporting 24
commerce, communication, public safety, and community life, 25
helping businesses thrive and ensuring that every American—no 26
matter where they live—remains connected to the broader nation; 27
and 28

WHEREAS, Maintaining a strong and stable Postal Service is 29
vital to our economy, our democracy, and our national security, 30
as well as to the well-being of countless families and small 31
businesses that depend on it; and 32

WHEREAS, The year 2025 marks the 250th anniversary of the 33
founding of the United States Postal Service, an institution 34
older than our nation itself and rooted in the principles of 35
service, reliability, and connection that continue to define it 36
today; now therefore be it 37

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 136th General 38
Assembly of the State of Ohio, in adopting this resolution, 39
recognize the 250th anniversary of the United States Postal 40
Service and expresses appreciation for its enduring service to 41
the people of the United States; and be it further 42

RESOLVED, That we celebrate the essential role of the 43
Postal Service in binding our nation together and supporting 44
commerce, communication, and community life across all regions 45
of the country; and be it further 46

RESOLVED, That we affirm the Postal Service as a trusted 47
and essential public service that belongs to all Americans; and 48

long-term strength, efficiency, and accessibility of the United	51
States Postal Service for generations to come; and be it further	52
RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House of Representatives	53
transmit duly authenticated copies of this resolution to the	54
Postmaster General, the President of the United States, the	55
Speaker and Clerk of the United States House of Representatives,	56
the President Pro Tempore and Secretary of the United States	57
Senate, the members of the Ohio Congressional delegation, and	58
