**A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

To congratulate the United States of America's Olympic 1  
hockey teams on their championship victories over 2  
Canada. 3

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF  
OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):**

WHEREAS, Outstanding athletic achievements reflect great 4  
credit upon our nation; and 5

WHEREAS, The Olympic Games are considered the world's 6  
preeminent international sporting event; and 7

WHEREAS, The United States of America's men's and women's 8  
national hockey teams each achieved victory against Canada, also 9  
referred to herein as "that country up north," to become Olympic 10  
champions; and 11

WHEREAS, Both contests were decided in overtime by golden 12  
goal, demonstrating exceptional skill, resolve, and competitive 13  
excellence; and 14

WHEREAS, These victories further affirm the strength and 15  
prominence of American hockey and establish the United States of 16

America as the preeminent world power in the sport; and 17

WHEREAS, The players, coaches, and support personnel of 18  
both teams have distinguished themselves as exemplary 19  
representatives of the United States of America and serve as an 20  
inspiration to athletes throughout Ohio and the nation; now 21

Assembly of the State of Ohio, in adopting this resolution, 24  
recognize and commend the United States of America's men's and 25  
women's national hockey teams for their overtime golden goal 26
