## A JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing to amend Section 6 of Article I of the 1 Constitution of the State of Ohio to prohibit slavery 2 or involuntary servitude in Ohio for the punishment of 3 crime. 4

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the State of5Ohio, three-fifths of the members elected to each house6concurring herein, that there shall be submitted to the electors7of the state, in the manner prescribed by law at the general8election to be held on November 4, 2025, a proposal to amend9Section 6 of Article I of the Constitution of the State of Ohio10to read as follows:11

## ARTICLE I 12 Section 6. There shall never be no-slavery in this state; 13 nor involuntary servitude, unless for the punishment of crime. 14 Upon conviction of a crime, an Ohio court or a probation 15

or parole agency may order the convicted person to engage in	16
education, counseling, treatment, community service, or other	17
alternatives to incarceration, as part of sentencing for the	18
crime, in accordance with programs that have been in place	19
historically or that may be developed in the future, to provide	20
accountability, reformation, protection of society, or	21
rehabilitation.	22

If adopted by a majority of the electors voting on this	24
proposal, Section 6 of Article I of the Constitution of the	25
State of Ohio amended by this proposal shall take effect	26
immediately and the existing version of Section 6 of Article I	27
of the Constitution of the State of Ohio is repealed from such	28
effective date.	29
