# A RESOLUTION

# BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

WHEREAS, On February 3, 2023, a freight train derailed in5East Palestine, Ohio, while carrying hazardous materials,6including vinyl chloride, ethylene glycol monobutyl ether,7ethyl-hexyl acrylate, butyl acrylates, benzene residue, and8isobutylene. In response, officials evacuated a one-mile radius9around the derailment location and then extended it to two miles10a few days later; and11

WHEREAS, The force of the crash caused several rail cars to12catch fire and others to spill their toxic loads onto the soil,13

work directed by EPA"; and

causing hazardous substances to travel into local waterways; and 14 WHEREAS, Emergency crews were forced to conduct controlled 15 burns of five vinyl chloride tank rail cars to limit potential 16 explosions. But as a result of the controlled burning, plumes of 17 black smoke containing hazardous chemicals were released into 18 the air; and 19 WHEREAS, In September 2023, President Biden issued 20 Executive Order 14108, "ensuring the people of East Palestine 21 are protected now and in the future." This Executive Order also 22 states, in pertinent part, that "available data show that no 23 contaminants of concern have been detected at levels of concern 24 in the air in the affected communities at sustained levels since 25 the evacuation order was lifted"; and 26 WHEREAS, The Executive Order also directed the Federal 27 Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to "oversee long-term 28 recovery efforts in the affected communities and conduct a 29 comprehensive assessment of unmet needs of the affected 30 communities in recovering from the derailment beyond the cleanup 31

WHEREAS, Newly-obtained documents acquired through a Freedom of Information Act request show that officials from FEMA voiced concerns that the chemical spill and the plume of smoke set off by the controlled burn could cause "cancer clusters"; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the House of38Representatives of the 136th General Assembly of the State of39Ohio, in adopting this resolution, urge Congress to establish a40special committee to investigate the East Palestine train41derailment and the United States Environmental Protection42Agency's response to it; and be it further43
