A RESOLUTION

Honoring Heritage Hill Farm on its Bicentennial.

reforestation project in 2002, which involved the planting of 30,000
native hardwood trees. In addition, the operation has worked with
regional state foresters to improve the surrounding forests, and

its owner, David Charles Winger, are to be commended for their
