(4) Removes the requirement that the state institution	52
must declare that it will not endorse or oppose any	53

(5) Removes the requirement that the state institution	55
must affirm and declare that it will not encourage, discourage,	56
require, or forbid students, faculty, or administrators to	57
endorse, assent to, or publicly express a given ideology.	58
(6) Modifies the prohibition against political and	59
ideological litmus tests by removing the prohibition against an	60
institution requiring applicants describe their commitment to	61
any ideology, principle, concept, or formulation that requires	62
commitment to any controversial belief or policy.	63

(7) Removes the requirement that a state institution must affirm and declare that no hiring, promotion, or admissions process or decision will encourage or forbid assent to a given ideology or political stance.

(8) Modifies the requirement that a state institution affirm and declare that it will not use a diversity statement in any hiring or admissions decision by removing the prohibition against any other assessment of an applicant's political or ideological views.

(9) Removes the requirement that a state institution affirm and declare that no process or decision regulating conditions of work or study will encourage or forbid assent to a given ideology or political stance.
