To enact section 5.57 of the Revised Code to	1
designate September 28 as "Speaker Jo Ann	2

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

<b>Section 1.</b> That section 5.57 of the Revised Code be	4
enacted to read as follows:	5

<u><b>Sec. 5.57.</b> The twenty-eighth day of September is</u>	6
<u>designated as "Speaker Jo Ann Davidson Day" in recognition of Jo</u>	7
<u>Ann Davidson, the first female speaker of the Ohio House of</u>	8
<u>Representatives, who was born on that day in 1927.</u>	9
