BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:	
Section 1. That sections 3301.0717 and 3313.6025 of the	4
Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 3301.0717. (A) As used in this section, "success	6
sequence" means a three-pronged framework for youth and young	7
adults based on research from diverse institutions that	8
individuals who complete at least a high school education,	9
obtain full-time work, and marry before having children are	10
overwhelmingly less likely to live in poverty in adulthood.	11
(B) The department of education and workforce shall	12
develop standards and a model curriculum about the success	13
sequence for grades six to twelve, which shall include evidence,	14
identified using the best research methods available, describing	15
the positive personal and societal outcomes associated with the	16
success sequence.	17
(C) The dependment shell establish a semmittee including	1.0
(C) The department shall establish a committee including	18
school district board of education members and parents of	19
students enrolled in school districts to review the standards	20

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and model curriculum, and instructional materials aligned with	21
them that may be used in annual success sequence discussions.	22
(D) The department may propose revisions to the success	23

by educators, representatives of institutions of higher	25

sequence" has the same meaning as in section 3301.0717 of the	34

Each school district board of education shall provide	36
instruction on the success sequence that is aligned with the	37
standards developed under section 3301.0717 of the Revised Code.	38
Each district shall include that instruction in one or more	39
courses offered under division (C) of section 3313.603 of the	4 C
Revised Code. Each district may use the model curriculum adopted	41
under section 3301.0717 of the Revised Code in providing that	42
instruction and may modify that curriculum as appropriate for	43
