To enact sections 3301.0717 and 3313.6025 of the 1
Revised Code regarding the success sequence 2
curriculum. 3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3301.0717 and 3313.6025 of the 4
Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 5

Sec. 3301.0717. (A) As used in this section, "success 6
sequence" means a three-pronged framework for youth and young 7
adults based on research from diverse institutions that 8
individuals who complete at least a high school education, 9
obtain full-time work, and marry before having children are 10
overwhelmingly less likely to live in poverty in adulthood. 11

(B) The department of education and workforce shall review 12
and maintain a list of curriculum and resources for grades six 13
to twelve about the success sequence. Any curriculum or 14
resources on this list shall include, and be consistent with, 15
evidence, identified using the best research methods available, 16
describing the positive personal and societal outcomes 17
associated with the success sequence. 18

Sec. 3313.6025. (A) Each school district board of 19
education shall provide instruction that is aligned with the 20
success sequence, as defined in section 3301.0717 of the Revised 21
Code using any of the following: 22

(1) A curriculum on the list reviewed and maintained by 23
the department of education and workforce under section 24
3301.0717 of the Revised Code; 25

(2) A different curriculum that is aligned with the 26
success sequence; 27

(3) A curriculum that integrates instruction that is 28
aligned with the success sequence with the curriculum 29
requirements in divisions (A) (5) (b) to (g) of section 3313.60 of 30
the Revised Code. 31

(B) Each district shall include instruction under this 32
section in one or more courses offered under division (C) of 33
section 3313.603 of the Revised Code. A district may provide 34
that instruction in the same or separate course in which it 35
provides instruction in the subjects listed in divisions (A) (5) 36
(b) to (g) of section 3313.60 of the Revised Code. 37
