BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5.2322 of the Revised Code be	4
enacted to read as follows:	5
<u>Sec. 5.2322. The fourth day of October is designated as</u>	6
<u>"Rutherford B. Hayes Day."</u>	7
