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To amend section 1546.04 of the Revised Code to 1  
require the ODNR Chief of the Division of Parks 2  
and Watercraft to establish a discount program 3  
for veterans and service members for park 4  
services and rentals. 5

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 1546.04 of the Revised Code be 6  
amended to read as follows: 7

**Sec. 1546.04.** (A) Except as provided in this section, the 8  
chief of the division of parks and watercraft, with the approval 9  
of the director of natural resources, shall adopt rules in 10  
accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code that are 11  
necessary for the proper management of state parks, bodies of 12

water, and the lands adjacent to them under its jurisdiction and control, including rules:	13 14
(1) Governing opening and closing times and dates of state parks;	15 16
(2) Establishing fees and charges for use of facilities in state parks;	17 18
(3) Governing camps, camping, and fees for camps and camping;	19 20
(4) Governing the application for and rental of, rental fees for, and the use of cottages;	21 22
(5) Relating to public use of state park lands, and governing the operation of motor vehicles, including speeds and parking on those lands;	23 24 25
(6) Governing all advertising within state parks and requirements for the operation of places selling tangible personal property and food service sales on lands and waters under the control of the division. The rules shall establish uniform requirements for those operations and sales.	26 27 28 29 30
(7) Providing uniform standards relating to the size, type, location, construction, and maintenance of structures and devices used for fishing or moorage of watercraft, rowboats, sailboats, and powercraft over waters under the control of the division and establishing reasonable fees for the construction of, and annual use permits for, those structures and devices;	31 32 33 34 35 36
(8) Governing state beaches, swimming, inflatable devices, and fees for them;	37 38
(9) Governing the removal and disposition of any watercraft, rowboat, sailboat, or powercraft left unattended for	39 40

more than seven days on any lands or waters under the control of 41  
the division; 42

(10) Governing the establishment and collection of check 43  
collection charges for checks that are returned to the division 44  
or dishonored for any reason; 45

(11) Governing natural resources officers in all parks and 46  
bodies of water and lands adjacent to those bodies under the 47  
supervision and control of the division as are necessary to the 48  
proper management of such parks and bodies of water. 49

~~(B)~~ (B) (1) The chief shall adopt rules in accordance with 50  
Chapter 119. of the Revised Code establishing a discount program 51  
for all persons who are issued a golden buckeye card under 52  
section 173.06 of the Revised Code. The discount program shall 53  
provide a discount for all park services and rentals, but shall 54  
not provide a discount for the purchase of merchandise. 55

(2) The chief also shall adopt rules in accordance with 56  
Chapter 119. of the Revised Code establishing a discount program 57  
for all veterans and service members who present, in a manner 58  
determined by the chief, a valid form of documentation. The 59  
discount program shall provide a twenty-five per cent discount 60  
for all park services and rentals but shall not provide a 61  
discount for the purchase of merchandise. 62

(3) As used in division (B) (2) of this section: 63

(a) "Veteran" and "service member" have the same meanings 64  
as in section 5903.01 of the Revised Code. 65

(b) "Valid form of documentation" means any of the 66  
following: 67

(i) An Ohio veterans identification card issued under 68

<u>section 317.241 of the Revised Code;</u>	69
<u>(ii) A United States department of defense authorized common access card;</u>	70 71
<u>(iii) A United States department of defense uniformed services identification and privilege card DD form 1173;</u>	72 73
<u>(iv) A United States department of defense issued next generation USID card;</u>	74 75
<u>(v) A military annual pass or military lifetime pass version of the national parks and federal recreational lands pass;</u>	76 77 78
<u>(vi) A veteran health identification card issued by the United States department of veterans affairs.</u>	79 80
(C) The chief, with the approval of the director of natural resources, may adopt rules in accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code that establish all of the following:	81 82 83
(1) Requirements governing the administration of state parks;	84 85
(2) Requirements considered necessary by the chief to supplement the identification, operation, titling, use, registration, and numbering of watercraft or vessels as provided in Chapters 1547. and 1548. of the Revised Code;	86 87 88 89
(3) Requirements governing the navigation of vessels on waters in this state, including rules regarding steering and sailing, the conduct of vessels in sight of one another or in restricted visibility, lights and shapes of lights used on vessels, and sound and light signals. As the chief considers necessary, the chief shall ensure that those rules are consistent with and equivalent to the regulations and	90 91 92 93 94 95 96

(5) Fees and charges for all of the following:	105
(a) Boating skill development classes and other	106
educational classes;	107
(b) Law enforcement services provided at special events	108
when the services are in addition to normal enforcement duties;	109
(c) Inspections of vessels or motors conducted under	110
Chapter 1547. or Chapter 1548. of the Revised Code.	111
(D) The chief shall not adopt rules under this section	112
establishing fees or charges for parking a motor vehicle in a	113
state park or for admission to a state park.	114
<b>Section 2.</b> That existing section 1546.04 of the Revised	115
Code is hereby repealed.	116
