"Sec. 3301.0717. (A) As used in this section, "success sequence" means a three-pronged framework for youth and young adults based on research from diverse institutions that individuals who complete at least a high school education, obtain full-time work, and marry before having children are overwhelmingly less likely to live in poverty in adulthood. 8

(B) The department of education and workforce shall review and maintain a list of curriculum and resources for grades six to twelve about the success sequence. Any curriculum or resources on this list shall include, and be consistent with, 14

evidence, identified using the best research methods available, 18
describing the positive personal and societal outcomes 19
associated with the success sequence. 20

Sec. 3313.6025. (A) Each school district board of 21
education shall provide instruction that is aligned with the 22
success sequence, as defined in section 3301.0717 of the Revised 23
Code using any of the following: 24

(1) A curriculum on the list reviewed and maintained by 25
the department of education and workforce under section 26
3301.0717 of the Revised Code; 27

(2) A different curriculum that is aligned with the 28
success sequence; 29

(3) A curriculum that integrates instruction that is 30
aligned with the success sequence with the curriculum 31
requirements in divisions (A) (5) (b) to (g) of section 3313.60 of 32
the Revised Code. 33

(B) Each district shall include instruction under this 34
section in one or more courses offered under division (C) of 35
section 3313.603 of the Revised Code. A district may provide 36
that instruction in the same or separate course in which it 37
provides instruction in the subjects listed in divisions (A) (5) 38
(b) to (g) of section 3313.60 of the Revised Code." 39

success sequence for grades 6-12 that include and are consistent	45
with the same evidence.	46
Requires each school district board of education to	47
provide instruction that is aligned with the success sequence.	48
Permits a school district to use one of the following in	49
providing that instruction:	50
1. A curriculum from the Department's list;	51
2. A different curriculum aligned with the success	52
sequence; or	53
3. A curriculum that integrates instruction aligned with	54
the success sequence with the specific topics a school district	55
must include in its health curriculum.	56
