Council and to make an appropriation. 2

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. (A) The Ohio Food and Agriculture Policy	3
Council is created to make recommendations to the General	4
Assembly regarding food systems that strengthen the state's food	5
and farm economies. The Council shall engage in advocacy,	6
education, and policy work to enhance the health and wellness of	7
the citizens of Ohio and to encourage the sustainability of	8
natural resources.	9
(B) The Council shall consist of the Director of	10
Agriculture or the Director's designee and all of the following	11
members appointed by the Governor:	12
(1) One member who represents the Ohio Hospital	13
Association;	14
(2) One member who represents Ohio State University	15
Extension;	16
(3) One member who represents Central State University	17
Extension;	18

(4) Three members who represent the Ohio Farm Bureau;	19
(5) One member who represents urban farming;	20
(6) One member who represents rural farming;	21
(7) One member who represents statewide food banks;	22
(8) One member who is a registered lobbyist who represents	23
Ohio cooperatives.	24
(C)(1) The Governor shall make appointments to the Council	25
not later than sixty days after the effective date of this	26
section. The Council shall convene not later than ninety days	27
after the effective date of this section. Each appointed member	28
of the Council shall serve for a four-year term. Each appointed	29
member is subject to removal at the pleasure of the Governor.	30
Any vacancy on the Council shall be filled in the same manner as	31
the original appointment. After the expiration of each appointed	32
member's four-year term, the Council ceases to exist.	33
(2) The Council shall be considered a part of the	34
Department of Agriculture for administrative purposes. The	35
Director of Agriculture or the Director's designee shall serve	36
as Chairperson of the Council. The Council may request from the	37
Director, and the Director shall provide, meeting space,	38
assistance, services, and information to enable the Council to	39
carry out its duties.	40
(D) The Council shall develop a statewide plan containing	41
policy and funding recommendations for promoting and supporting	42
an equitable, healthy, and sustainable food system on the state	43
and local level. The Council shall engage in educational	44
outreach and shall make recommendations to the General Assembly	45
as needed. The Council also shall compile and deliver, not later	46
than the first day of March each year, an annual report to the	47
