DETAILED ANALYSIS

License Plate	Land of U.S. Grant license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by the representatives of the Land of U.S. Grant and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. ¹
Recipients	Available to all applicants.
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.
Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution	\$20 required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee. Contributions must be paid to the Land of U.S. Grant. The organization must use the contributions to further the organization's mission. ²
Requirements for Issuance	1. Submission of an application; 2. Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and 3. Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
