Highlights

- School districts and other public schools may incur minimal costs to update their current health curricula to provide the fetal development instruction required by the bill.

Detailed Analysis

The bill requires, beginning in the 2026-2027 school year, school districts and other public schools to include instruction on fetal development as part of any health education instruction addressing human growth, development, or sexuality. The curriculum must include a video at least three minutes long of either a high-quality computer generated animation or a high-definition ultrasound video, that shows the development of the brain, heart, and other vital organs in early fetal development.

Districts and schools may incur minimal costs to implement instruction on fetal development into existing health curriculum and lesson plans. Videos that meet the bill's requirements are available online at no cost, but any other materials that districts or schools choose to use could increase expenditures, depending on the materials, availability, and cost.
