## Bill Analysis

### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"Cleveland Police Officer Jamieson Ritter Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The portion of U.S. Route 322, running in an easterly and westerly direction, between E. 40 <sup>th</sup> Street and E. 81 <sup>st</sup> Street in Cleveland
<b>Other Information</b>	Police Officer Jamieson Ritter was killed in the line of duty on July 4, 2024, when he was shot while attempting to arrest a suspect wanted on a felony charge. He had served with the Cleveland Division of Police for four years and was also a member of the Ohio Army National Guard.
