DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Cleveland Police Officer Jamieson Ritter Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The portion of U.S. Route 322, running in an easterly and westerly direction, between E. 40 th Street and E. 81 st Street in Cleveland
Other Information	Police Officer Jamieson Ritter was killed in the line of duty on July 4, 2024, when he was shot while attempting to arrest a suspect wanted on a felony charge. He had served with the Cleveland Division of Police for four years and was also a member of the Ohio Army National Guard.
