### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"Trooper Nicholas P. Cayton Memorial Highway" <sup>2</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 11 between U.S. Route 224 and Leffingwell Road, in Mahoning County
<b>Other Information</b>	Trooper Nicholas P. Cayton was an Ohio Army National Guard veteran and had served with the Ohio State Highway Patrol for 13 years at the time of his death. On October 16, 2025, he was struck and killed in the line of duty by a semi-truck on Route 11 in Canfield, Ohio, while he was responding to a disabled tractor-trailer.
