A RESOLUTION

Association in 1875 with seventy-five supporters, the organization was
ever-changing and dependent on subscriptions before closing in 1888,
and in 1914, the women of the Shakespeare Round Table opened the first

the flourishing system that has become a pillar of its community, and
it is truly deserving of high praise; and

Library has fostered education, culture, and individual growth by
providing a variety of innovative and beneficial programs and
