around him, including his wife, Chun, his two children, Kimberly and
Edward, and his many siblings, nieces, and nephews, and although the
void his death has created can never be filled, the legacy of care and
commitment he established will surely live on; and

WHEREAS, Andy Lansing's concern for improving the quality of life
in our society was clearly evident in the contributions he made to his
community. Among his endeavors, he was a member of Orient Lodge 321 of
the Free and Accepted Masons and the Pike County Shrine Club, and the
warmth and understanding that he so readily extended to others will
