president of military strategy for R2 Associate and a commissioner of
the Ohio Military Facilities Commission before being appointed by
Governor Mike DeWine in 2019 as the director of the Ohio Department of
Veterans Services, where she has supported Ohio's veterans in all of
her efforts; and
