of Ohio were deeply saddened to learn of the passing of Mary Rose Oakar and extend our heartfelt condolences to her family and friends; 3 and WHEREAS, Mary Rose Oakar left an indelible impression on the 5 people whose lives she touched, and she will be remembered as a 6 spirited individual who contributed immeasurably to the world around 7 her. Widely renowned for her prolific career in public service, she 9 served three years on the Cleveland City Council and then sixteen years in the U.S. House of Representatives serving Ohio's 20th 10 District, where she was instrumental in supporting legislation 11 affecting women's and elder issues, government employees, Social 12 Security, and fair compensation as well as securing resources for the 13 revitalization of downtown Cleveland and the surrounding area, and she was the first Democratic woman from Ohio, Arab-American woman, Syrian-15 American, and Lebanese-American woman to be elected to this position. 16 She went on to be sworn in to the Ohio House of Representatives and 17 then to hold the posts of member of the Ohio State Board of Education 18 and president of the American-Arab Anti-Discrimination Committee. 19 Indeed, she will be remembered for her generosity, talents, and 20 seemingly inexhaustible energy; and 21
