A BILL

To establish the Columbus State Logistics Program 1
and to make an appropriation. 2

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. All items in this section are hereby appropriated as 3
designated out of any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the 4
designated fund. For all appropriations made in this act, those in the 5
first column are for fiscal year 2016 and those in the second column are 6
for fiscal year 2017. The appropriations made in this act are in addition 7
to any other appropriations made for the FY 2016-FY 2017 biennium. 8

COLUMBUS STATE LOGISTICS PROGRAM 15

The foregoing appropriation item 235517, Columbus State Logistics 16

Program, shall be used to support workforce development initiatives 17
through the Columbus State Community College Logistics Program. 18

Section 2. Within the limits set forth in this act, the Director of 19
Budget and Management shall establish accounts indicating the source and 20
amount of funds for each appropriation made in this act, and shall 21
determine the form and manner in which appropriation accounts shall be 22
maintained. Expenditures from appropriations contained in this act shall 23
be accounted for as though made in the main operating appropriations act 24
of the 131st General Assembly. 25

The appropriations made in this act are subject to all provisions of 26
the main operating appropriations act of the 131st General Assembly that 27
are generally applicable to such appropriations. 28
