I would like to comment on how difficult it is for people such as myself to have a license reinstatement. I am honestly not sure what the current laws state but I know that many things that have nothing to do with driving or traffic laws can get your license suspended.

For example a Warrant Block -

1. Say I owe court fines which I due to lack of financial availability can not pay in the allowed amount of time. The court may issue a warrant for me to appear to address this in which case my license will be suspended immediately. This means I have no transportation to get to court to address the warrant or get to work. I live in an area with no public transportation system. Now I run risk of losing my job, going to jail for failure to appear, or agreeing more penalties and a cost for driving under suspension making it range from \$15.00 to a possibility of \$100's of dollars depending on the reinstatement fees. Now I have lost my license and been put in a position that makes it impossible to get it back and the only crime I have committed is being broke and in the lower class. This could cause those
