

OHIO SENATE
Committee on Transportation, Commerce and Workforce Minutes
February 27, 2019
133rd General Assembly

The Senate Committee on Transportation, Commerce, and Workforce was called to order pursuant to the meeting notice at approximately 1:00p.m. in the Finance Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The Chair called up the appointments of Sheryl Maxfield as the Director of the Department of Commerce, Michael Giarrizzo, Jr. to the Board of Motor Vehicle Repair, Christopher Macisco the Board of Motor Vehicle Repair, and Christopher Speck the Board of Motor Vehicle Repair. Senator Uecker moved these appointments be favorably reported to the Committee on Rules and Reference. The motion was agreed to by a vote of 11-0.
